Dear Mr. Baur:

As you are aware, on May 8, 2009, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued an Order Granting Motion for Default Judgment; Imposing Penalties (Docket UT-080455) against WTI, LLC (WT) in the amount of \$73,000 for several violations of commission rules governing telecommunications companies.


In addition, on June 30, 2009, the commission issued a Penalty Assessment (Docket UT-090995) against WTI in the amount of \$100 for violation of commission rules requiring telecommunications companies to file annual reports with the commission by May 1 each year.

The commission has not received either the \$73,000 or the \$100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$73,100 balance.
