- A. Aside from the safety and quality of live component of redirecting truck traffic away from schools and residential areas, Piert Road represents a major piece of the overall multi-modal transportation matrix in the Finley area of eastern Benton County. The low-lying, near-shore areas of Finley have long been viewed as a potential industrial, shipping, and manufacturing asset for the region; but realizing that potential has proven elusive in large part due to the lack of fluid, efficient overland transportation options into the area. As a result, recruiting the types of targeted operations into the appropriately zoned areas has been difficult.

A major milestone was reached in just the last few years with the completion of County Road 397, usually referred to colloquially as the "Finley Intertie". The Intertie highway, first envisaged in the 1960s, provides access into and out of Finley via a southwestern route to Interstate 82. Piert Road, and improvements to it, now take on greater importance as it can serve as a primary local access road for industry in south Finley, and connect into the Intertie.
