Enclosed for filing in the above-referenced dockets are a Settlement Agreement and Narrative, on behalf of Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), Harrison-Ray Water Company, and Harrison WaterCompany/Kiona, LLC (together, "Parties), and Certificate of Service.
