RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance DG-180901 – Evergreen Concrete Cutting – Investigation #7866

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Evergreen Concrete Cutting (Evergreen Concrete or Company) dated March 18, 2019. Order 01, approving settlement stipulation and agreement, required the following items be met:

• \$6,000 penalty for three violations of RCW 19.122.030(2), with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$4,000 of the penalty amount if the Company incurs no additional dig law violations within 12 months.

On April 19, 2019, the Company made a payment of \$2,000. The Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the order.

Staff believes that Evergreen Concrete has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$4,000 penalty amount and close this docket.
