Dear Mr. Johnson:

On February 6, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01 Order Granting Application for Sale and Transfer of Assets. Order 01, among other things, requires Northwest Water Services (NWWS) to finalize financing for a treatment system on the silverlake water system, within 90 days of Order 01.¹ Orders, 02, 03, and 04, granted extensions to December 31, 2020. On January 29, 2021 NWWS finalized their financing for the treatment plant and has now complied with Order 01.

Staff finds the company in compliance with docket UW-191063 Order 04 and recommends the commission close the docket effective February 2, 2021. If you have any questions please let me know.
