## TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 8, 2020, the Commission entered Order 01, Consolidating Dockets, Approving Safety Management Plan; Upgrading Safety Rating; Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 01). Order 01 assessed a reduced penalty of \$12,400 and suspended a \$8,000 portion of the penalty for two years, subject to the conditions that (1) Queen City maintains a conditional safety rating, (2) Staff conducts a follow-up investigation at least six months from the effective date of Order 01, (3) Queen City does not incur any repeat critical violations of WAC 480-15 upon reinspection, and (4) Queen City either pays the \$4,450 portion of the penalty that is not suspended or works with Commission staff (Staff) to establish a mutually agreeable payment arrangement within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01.

On December 22, 2020, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 02), which allowed Queen City to pay the portion of the penalty that was not suspended in 15 payments, with the final payment due on February 25, 2022.

On January 4, 2023, Staff filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had met the conditions and completed payment of the unsuspended portion of the penalty. Staff recommends that the Commission waive the suspended portion of the penalty. The Commission finds that Queen City has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The Commission thus waives the suspended portion of the penalty and closes this docket.
