- 1 On November 14, 2024, Eagle Towncar Service LLC (Eagle Towncar or Applicant) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as an auto transportation company in Washington (Application). The Application lists Mintensinot Selewondim as Eagle Towncar's manager.
- 2 On November 20, 2024, Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Premier Airport Shuttle/Capital Aeroporter (PNTS) filed with the Commission an application for Extension of certificate C000862 (Extension Request).
- 3 On December 6, 2024, Eagle Towncar filed an objection to the Extension Request (Objection), indicating that the Extension Request covers much of the same service area

covered by Eagle Towncar's temporary authority granted under Certificate TAC071487 by Order 02 in Docket TC-240717 on November 27, 2024.

- 4 Pursuant to Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 34.05.482 and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether Eagle Towncar's Application for permanent authority should be granted or PNTS' Extension Request should be granted.
- 5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a virtual brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, March 14, 2025. - 6 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- 7 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Lacey, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- 8 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, March 7, 2025**, and email such documents to the presiding officer, also by 5 p.m. on Friday, March 7, 2025.
- 9 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
