Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company), a division of PacifiCorp, submits to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission one verified confidential and redacted copy of the \$400,000,000 Credit Agreement, dated June 30, 2016, among PacifiCorp, the Banks party thereto, and JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., as Administrative Agent. This credit agreement replaces the \$600,000,000 Credit Agreement dated June 28, 2012, which was terminated on June 30, 2016. Commercially sensitive information has been redacted from the enclosed credit agreement. The Company has provided notices related to this credit agreement on May 10, 2016, and June 23, 2016, in Docket UE- 160490.

Because PacifiCorp has not made any new borrowing in connection with the referenced transaction, no Report of Securities Issued is enclosed.
