NOTICE CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Complainant, v. Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities, Respondent, Dockets UE-110876 and UG-110877 (consolidated)*

TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On November 3, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Prehearing Conference setting a prehearing conference for November 14, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. At the prehearing conference, the Commission intended to take up contested procedural issues, including the response time for data requests between the parties, in the decoupling phase of the above-referenced matter.

On November 9, 2011, Northwest Energy Coalition (Coalition) filed a letter on behalf of all parties to the case stating that they had reached agreement on the issue of response time for data requests. The Coalition suggested that any remaining procedural issues, such as establishing a procedural schedule, could be addressed informally. Details of the decoupling procedural schedule will be worked out informally between the parties and the presiding officer and the prehearing conference should be cancelled.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the prehearing conference in this matter scheduled to convene at 10:00 a.m., on November 14, 2011, is cancelled.
