In compliance with condition 8 – Broadband Improvement of the Settlement Agreement, approved by the Commission in the CenturyTel-Embarq Merger, Docket No. UT-082119, CenturyLink hereby provides a report of progress on this condition.

CenturyLink is pleased to report that it has exceeded its commitment to provision broadband to 2,200 residential lines within three years of the closing of the merger by enabling an additional 2,667 residential lines within 18 months of the closing of the merger.
