NOTICE OF SUBSTITUTION OF PRESIDING OFFICER

RE: In the Matter of the Petition of the CenturyLink Companies – Qwest Corporation; CenturyTel of Washington; CenturyTel of Interisland; CenturyTel of Cowiche; and United Telephone company of the Northwest – to be Competitively Classified Pursuant to RCW 80.36.320, Docket UT-240029

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 8, 2024, the CenturyLink Companies – Qwest Corporation, CenturyTel of Washington, CenturyTel of Inter Island, CenturyTel of Cowiche, and United Telephone Company of the Northwest (collectively referred to as CenturyLink or Company) – filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition for Competitive Classification (Petition) pursuant to the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 80.36.320 and the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-121-061.

On January 25, 2024, the Commission issued a Notice of Virtual Prehearing Conference which, among other things, assigned this matter to Administrative Law Judge Paige Doyle to preside with the Commissioners.
