Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to Paragraph 39 of the Commission's Final Order designating TracFone Wireless, Inc. ("TracFone") as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in Docket UT-093012, TracFone hereby provides notice to the Commission of a change in its terms and conditions of service offered to its SafeLink Wireless[®] Lifeline customers. Commencing December 1, 2017, TracFone's SafeLink Wireless[®] Lifeline customers who receive bundled voice and mobile broadband data service will receive a free monthly allotment of 350 airtime minutes, unlimited text messaging and 1 GB of broadband data. Prior to December 1, 2017, the monthly broadband data usage allowance was 500 MB. This revision is required by Section 54.408 the Federal Communications Commission's rules (*see* 47 C.F.R. § 54.408(b)(2)(ii)(B)), which states that the minimum service standard for the mobile broadband data usage allowance provided as part of Lifeline service is 1 GB per month during the period of December 1, 2017 through November 30, 2018.
