Description	<p>Sirs/Madams:</p> <p>I am writing as a resident, water customer, and Homeowners Association Board member in Orcas Highlands, with respect to the proposed rate increase of water rates by Rosario Utilities.</p> <p>You have a hearing scheduled for May 23 in Olympia about which we have only recently received notice. It is an undue hardship on all of the water users under Rosario Utilities to travel off-island and attend a midweek hearing. It is my request that the hearing be postponed and the venue changed to a location on Orcas Island.</p> <p>It is also imperative that your office direct Rosario Utilities to distribute to all customers a thorough explanation of their costs which they state should be borne by residential customers. Additionally, I request that you require Rosario Utilities to explain how and why they propose folding "unrecovered" prior loan capital cost and future capital costs into ongoing operating costs.</p> <p>I have had two contacts with Rosario Utilities and have requested information that has not been forthcoming. The bookkeeping and spread sheets that have found their way in to my hands display shoddy bookkeeping and unclear information. At this point, I would state that the situation with the Rosario Utilities rate increase and proposed sale are in a state of chaos. Please bring clarity to this situation, and postpone the May 23 hearing.</p>

 In a prior email, I requested that your commission postpone the subject-named hearing from May 23 to a future date on Orcas Island. I have been informed by a colleague that this hearing is unlikely to be postponed irrespective of the need and/or requests from those of us involved.

I, therefore, thoughtfully request that the WUTC Suspend the rate increase proposed by Rosario Utilities until a meeting can be scheduled (at our expense) on Orcas Island.

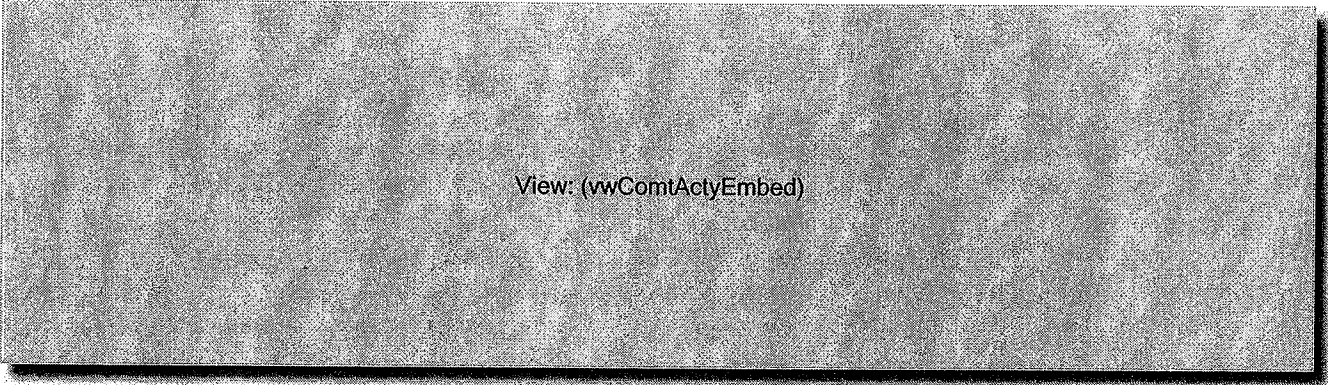
