NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING (Set for March 19, 2018, at 9:30 a.m.)

RE: In re Application of Man and a Van, Inc. for a permit to operate as a motor carrier of household goods

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 20, 2017, Man and a Van Inc. (Man and a Van or Applicant) filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) for authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington (Application).

On June 29, 2017, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority; Notice of Opportunity for Hearing. On June 30, 2017, the Company filed with the Commission a request for hearing. The Commission set the matter as a brief adjudicative proceeding, then continued the hearing twice at the parties' requests. Commission staff (Staff) represented that it made several attempts to work with the Company to reschedule the hearing, and ultimately recommended the Commission schedule a brief adjudicative proceeding without the Company's input to dispose of the pending Application.

On February 21, 2018, the Commission issued an Amended Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements, set for March 19, 2018, at 9:30 a.m.

On March 13, 2018, Man and a Van withdrew its Application. Staff neither objects to the Company's withdrawal nor opposes cancelling the brief adjudicative proceeding.

Because the Company's withdrawal of its Application eliminates the underlying dispute in this docket, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding.
