NOTICE CONCERNING DATE FOR ENTRY OF INITIAL ORDER

Re: In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against: DOLLY, INC., Docket TV-171212

TO ALL PARTIES:

The Commission conducted a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (BAP) in this docket on March 13, 2018. WAC 480-07-610(6) provides that: "[t]he presiding officer will enter an initial order that addresses the issues raised by the application within ten days after the date of the brief adjudication." The Commission heard direct testimony and cross-examination of two witnesses who appeared at the BAP hearing. It is important that the Presiding Officer have the transcript of this testimony available prior to finalizing and entering an Initial Order. There is, therefore, good cause to extend the time limit for entry of an Initial Order to the date that falls ten business days after the transcript becomes available for review.²

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that it will modify the time limits for entry of an Initial Order as discussed in the preceding paragraph.
