TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 4, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 02, Stipulated Initial Order Classifying Respondent as Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance (Order 02) against Tiger Express Shipping Corporation, d/b/a Tiger Travel, (Tiger Travel or Company). Order 02 imposed a penalty of \$5,000 against Tiger Travel, \$4,500 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, on the conditions that: a) Tiger Travel refrain from operating as a charter party or excursion carrier in Washington without first obtaining the required certificate, and b) pay the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On May 28, 2020, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that Staff believes the Company has refrained from operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier in this state. Staff recommends the suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission finds that Tiger Travel has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$4,500 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
