Dear Mr. Johnson:

On April 26, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Allowing Tariff Revisions to Become Effective Subject to Conditions in Docket TG-180267. In that docket, Zippy Disposal Service Inc., (Zippy or Company) filed tariff pages implementing a new residential recycling program. The conditions in Order 01 stipulated the Company was to file again effective December 1, 2019, to adjust rates based on actual cost experience.¹ Extensions to the filing deadline were subsequently requested and approved in Orders 02, 03, and 04 in that docket, with a final revised effective date of April 1, 2021. On February 16, 2021, Zippy made the compliance filing in which they indicated that program costs have not decreased and proposed to keep the rates the same. Staff reviewed the filing and agrees with the Company’s evaluation and concludes that the Company has now complied with Order 04.
