SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

CenturyLink<sup>1</sup> hereby applies for authority pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, and Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, to grandfather its Enterprise SIP Trunking (ESIP) service in all states and jurisdictions where the service is offered. CenturyLink ultimately plans to discontinue these services but is not seeking authority to do so at this time.

CenturyLink submits the following information in support of its application:

**2. Date of planned service discontinuance**

As of March 20, 2020, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained, CenturyLink will no longer offer ESIP service to new customers nor accept new orders from existing customers (except to the extent such orders are permitted by contract). Existing customers of these services will be grandfathered as follows:

- Existing contracts for these services will not be renewed.
- Customers with a contract may retain affected services on a month-to-month basis once that contract expires.

**3. Points of geographic areas of service affected**

CenturyLink seeks authority to grandfather the provision of ESIP service in Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, the District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Nebraska, New Jersey, New Mexico, Nevada, New York, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and Wisconsin.

**4. Brief description of the type of services affected**

Enterprise SIP Trunking is a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) service that allows the sharing of SIP call paths across two redundant IP-PBX platforms and provides bi-directional Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery functionality.

CenturyLink is grandfathering ESIP service because the service is at the end of its product life cycle, as the equipment associated with this service has been discontinued by the manufacturer and is no longer supported.

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the grandfathering of the services described herein. No other products or services are impacted by this application.

**5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers**

CenturyLink notified its customers of the plan to grandfather ESIP service in a letter sent via U.S. Mail on January 27, 2020. Those customers were notified that the proposed grandfathering would take effect on March 20, 2020, or as soon after that date as authorized by the relevant regulatory commissions. A copy of the customer notification letter is appended hereto. (*See Attachment A.*)

**6. Dominance of carrier with respect to the service to be grandfathered**

CenturyLink is a non-dominant carrier with regard to the services to be grandfathered.

**7. Service**

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), CenturyLink has mailed a copy of this application to the Governor and public utility commission of each affected state identified in

Paragraph 3 above, to any federally-recognized Tribal Nations with authority over the Tribal lands in the geographic areas identified in Paragraph 3 above, as well as to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications under the Secretary of Defense<sup>2</sup>.

At CenturyLink, our goal is to provide you with great quality and value while still remaining competitive. Changing market conditions require that we continually evaluate our prices, product offerings and infrastructure.

Occasionally our evaluation directs us to make changes to some products; therefore we are writing to inform you that CenturyLink is grandfathering, and ultimately discontinuing, the Enterprise Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) Trunking product offered by its Level 3 Telecom affiliates in Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, the District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Nebraska, New Jersey, New Mexico, Nevada, New York, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and Wisconsin. This action is necessary because the equipment associated with these services has been discontinued by the manufacturer and is no longer supported.

Enterprise SIP Trunking is a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) service that allows the sharing of SIP call paths across two redundant IP-PBX platforms and provides bi-directional Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery functionality.

As of March 20, 2020, or as soon after that date as authorized by the Federal Communications Commission and relevant state regulatory commissions, Level 3 Telecom's Enterprise SIP Trunking product will no longer be available to new customers or for new orders from existing customers.

Service to existing customers of these services will be grandfathered and discontinued as follows:

- Existing contracts for these services will not be renewed.
- Customers with a contract may retain affected services on a month-to-month basis once that contract expires.


