NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS OR STATUS REPORT (By December 3, 2019)

RE: Wash. Utils. & Transp. Comm'n v. Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. Docket TG-190476

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 17, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint for Penalties and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements on August 20, 2019, at 9:30 a.m. (Complaint) against Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc., (Peninsula or Company) for alleged violations of Title 81 RCW and Chapter 480-07 WAC. That brief adjudicative proceeding was rescheduled for October 16, 2019, and was subsequently cancelled pursuant to a joint request filed by Peninsula and Commission staff (Staff).

On November 5, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) notified the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement in principle, and indicated that the parties intended to file a settlement agreement by November 20, 2019.

On November 6, 2019, the Commission granted the parties' request, suspended the procedural schedule, and required the parties to file either a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report of their negotiations by November 20, 2019.

On November 20, 2019, the Company contacted the presiding officer via email and requested that the deadline to file the settlement agreement and supporting documentation be moved to December 3, 2019. Staff agrees with the request.

The Commission finds good cause to grant the parties' request and that doing so is consistent with the public interest and the Commission's administrative needs. The parties must file

either a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report by December 3, 2019.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the parties must file either a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report no later than December 3, 2019.
