ERRATUM TO ORDER 01

RE: *In the Matter of Puget Sound Energy 2020-2029 Ten-Year Achievable Electric Conservation Potential and 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Target Under RCW 19.285.040 and WAC 480-109-010*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 1, 2019, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or the Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Plan (Plan) to comply with Washington Administrative Code 480-109-010.

On December 17, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01, Accepting 2020-2029 Ten-Year Achievable Conservation Potential and 2020-2021 Biennial Conservation Target, Subject to Conditions (Order 01). It has come to the Commission's attention that in paragraphs 34 and 35, the threshold amounts referenced are incorrect. The Commission hereby corrects those paragraphs as follows:

- 34 (11) PSE's calculation of its 2020-2021 EIA Penalty Threshold of 336,297 MWh is consistent with RCW 19.285.040(1) and WAC 480-109-120(1).
- 35 (12) PSE's calculation of its 2020-2021 2020-2021 Decoupling Penalty Threshold of 17,993 MWh is consistent with Order 07 in Docket UE-121697.
