Public Counsel is filing this letter to update the previous status report, sent to the Commission on April 21, 2009, regarding the customer notice in the above-captioned case. The notice is expected to be included in customer bills during PacifiCorp's September 2009 billing cycle.

PacifiCorp, Public Counsel, and the Commission Consumer Protection and Communications Division (the parties) have exchanged drafts and participated in conference calls regarding the substance and format of the notice.
