COMPLAINANTS' MOTION TO
AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER

1. Complainants request that the Commission change the date by which motions to compel must be filed under Order No. 10. The due date for filing motions to compel is November 19, 2008. Complainants ask that this date be changed to November 26, 2008—a one week extension. We are not requesting a change in any of the other deadlines. Both respondents have agreed with this modification.

2. This modification to the scheduling order is requested because counsel for the complainants, Chris Youtz, will have surgery on Thursday, November 13—the day following the due date for the responses to discovery. The recovery time for the surgery is expected to be four to five days, which will allow little time to review the responses to discovery, confer with counsel, and file motions to compel if the disagreements over the scope of discovery are not resolved. An additional week should allow the parties time to confer and, if necessary, to file their motions to compel. The other dates are not affected by this request. Thus, this brief one-week extension will not conflict with the

Commission's prompt adjudication of this matter, the preparation of any party, or the interests of justice.
