## PSE Data Request No. 010 to WUTC Staff:

Is it Staff's position that PSE should rely solely on market and not lock in fixed prices? If not, what circumstances should PSE lock in fixed prices?

## **RESPONSE:**

No. Staff outlined the scope of its testimony in Exhibit No. \_ (DCG-1HCT), Page 3, Lines 1-12. Staff confined its testimony to making recommendations to support a decision by the Commission to either approve or disapprove the PPA based on:

- 1. Whether the terms of the Agreement provide adequate protection to ratepayers and PSE throughout the life of the contract or in the event of early termination; and
- 2. The long-term economic risks and benefits of the PPA are equitably shared between PSE and its ratepayers.

Therefore, the context for Staff's comments/concerns regarding the fixed priced nature of the PPA relate to ratepayer risks described in Staff's response to PSE Data Request No. 3a.
