- 1 **Proceeding:** This matter involves a proceeding initiated by Commission Staff against telecommunications companies that did not comply with regulatory requirements for 2002 or 2001. The Commission gave notice to all affected companies on September 30, 2003, of the appropriate steps to avoid revocation of its registration.

- 2 The Commission entered its final order revoking the registration of those companies that failed to submit required reports and pay regulatory fees on December 22, 2003.

- 3 On January 5, 2004, Vanilla, Inc., filed with the Commission a petition for reconsideration along with its 2002 Annual Report and 2003 Regulatory Fees. It argues that it is a small organization that has had several changes in management and has recently reorganized itself and is prepared to stay in compliance with regulatory authorities.

- 4 RCW 34.05.470(1)¹ states that a petition for reconsideration is timely if it is filed within ten days of the final order. The last day for filing a petition for reconsideration was January 2, 2004. The Commission received the petition on January 5, 2004, and it is therefore late-filed. The Commission’s authority to

change time limits established by statute are limited by RCW 34.05.080, which does not permit acceptance of the petition in this docket.

- 5 The Commission denies Vanilla, Inc.'s petition for reconsideration of the Commission final order in this docket.
