PACIFIC POWER'S MOTION TO AMEND ORDER 01

I. INTRODUCTION

In accordance with WAC 480-07-875(1), Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, respectfully requests the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to Amend Order 01 in Docket UE-031658. Order 01 authorized Pacific Power to record and defer costs prudently incurred in connection with its environmental remediation program and required semiannual reports of its environmental remediation costs. Pacific Power requests that the Commission modify the semi-annual reporting requirement to an annual report due on May 15 of each year. Pacific Power has discussed this motion with Staff and understands they are supportive of the amendment requested.

II. BACKGROUND

Pacific Power is an electric utility and public service company doing business in the state of Washington under RCW 80.04.010, and its public utility operations, retail rates, service, and accounting practices are subject to the Commission's jurisdiction. PacifiCorp also provides retail electricity service under the name Pacific Power in Oregon and California and under the name Rocky Mountain Power in Idaho, Utah, and Wyoming. III. REQUEST

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Since the Commission entered Order 01 in this docket, Pacific Power has been including semi-annual environmental reports along with the company's quarterly results of operations reports. In discussions with the company, Commission staff recommended that the company submit reports on an annual basis consistent with the practices of other utilities in Washington. Accordingly, Pacific Power is making this motion to request that the Commission modify paragraph 13 of Order 01 to change from semi-annual reports to an annual compliance report in this docket.

In addition, Pacific Power requests to modify the annual filing's due date to

May 15 of each year. This would allow the company to provide reports on a calendar

year basis, which is consistent with the company's current accounting practices.

IV. CONCLUSION

Pacific Power respectfully requests that the Commission modify the semi-annual environmental remediation reporting requirement to an annual compliance report due on May 15 of each year.
