Pursuant to RCW 80.28.050 and 80.28.060 and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's ("Commission") Rules and Regulations, PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp" or "the Company") transmits herewith for filing and approval by the Commission three copies of proposed new tariff sheets applicable to electric service supplied by the Company in the state of Washington to become effective on March 7, 2008. In accordance with WAC 480-07-510(2), this copy is provided in legislative format.

Also enclosed pursuant to WAC 480-07-510(1) are nineteen (19) paper copies of the Company's Application and all testimony and exhibits that the Company intends to present as its direct case if the filing is suspended and a hearing held. One copy of the testimony and exhibits in electronic format is also included. Please note that certain of the exhibits are marked as "confidential" and are provided in accordance with the requirements of WAC 480-07-160(3). The Company will be seeking a protective order in accordance with WAC 480-07-420 at the prehearing conference with respect to these confidential exhibits. The confidential exhibits in Mr. Tallman's testimony contain commercially sensitive information regarding the resource acquisition process, the disclosure of which could disadvantage the Company and its customers in the negotiation of future resource acquisitions. The confidential exhibit in Mr. Williams' testimony includes sensitive market pricing information that, if available to potential investors, may disadvantage the Company in its future financings and thereby result in higher capital costs to customers.

As required by WAC 480-07-510(3), enclosed please find copies of supporting workpapers, which, due to the considerable size of the documents, have been provided in electronic format on an enclosed CD. Paper copies will be supplied upon request. As required by WAC 480-07-510(7), also enclosed are one copy of each of the following: the Company's most recent annual report to shareholders; the Company's most recent FERC Form 1; and the Company's Form 10Ks, Form 10Qs, prospectuses for any issuances of securities, and quarterly reports to shareholders (if any) for the most recent two years prior to the filing date.

By the enclosed tariff sheets, PacifiCorp requests an increase in revenues from Washington operations resulting in an overall price change of 14.6% or \$34.9 million. The proposed new tariff sheets are contained in Exhibit No.__(WRG-2) accompanying this filing. The filing is based upon a test period of the twelve months ended June 30, 2007, adjusted for known and measurable changes through June 30, 2008.

The Company agrees that upon suspension of its tariff filing, it will provide notice pursuant to WAC 480-100-197. Accordingly, the notice provisions of WAC 480-100-194 are not required for this filing. Attached as Attachment A is a listing of the tariff sheets proposed to be revised. Attachment B is the Printed Index for all electronic files of this filing. In addition, the Company seeks amortization annually of \$2.5 million related to the hydro deferral previously authorized by the Commission. If approved, it would result in an overall price change of 1.0%
