4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Roger Garratt. My business address is 10885 NE 4th Street, P.O. Box
6 97034, Bellevue WA 98009-9734.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Director of Financial
9 Planning & Strategic Initiatives.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Financial Planning & Strategic**
11 **Initiatives?**

12 A. My present responsibilities include oversight of: (i) the acquisition and
13 development of electric resources for PSE; (ii) contracts for long-term electric
14 supply; (iii) PSE's emerging technology investigations and strategies; (iv) PSE's
15 five-year financial plan; and (v) PSE's 20-year load forecast.

1 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

2 A. I graduated from the University of Nebraska with a Bachelor of Science degree in
3 electrical engineering. I also received a Masters of Business
4 Administration (MBA) degree from Union College, Schenectedy, NY.

5 I have over 30 years of diversified experience in the energy industry, including
6 development, acquisitions, capital equipment sales, after-market parts and service
7 sales and marketing, and extensive knowledge of western energy markets and
8 organizations.

9 From 1977 to 1991, I worked at General Electric, where, among other positions,
10 I was a Turbine Sales Manager responsible for sales of power generation
11 equipment and associated services in the seven-state, Northwest Region.

12 From 1991 to 1994, I was employed at the J. Makowski Company, Inc., a Boston-
13 based energy development company, which was purchased by Pacific Gas &
14 Electric National Energy Group (“PG&E NEG”) in 1994. At J. Makowski
15 Company, Inc., I established a market presence for the company in the Northwest
16 region and initiated development of two projects in Washington.

17 From 1994-2002, I was employed at PG&E NEG, where I was employed as
18 Director of Project Development. In this capacity I was responsible for managing
19 all aspects of project development, including the La Paloma Generating Project
20 (from 1997-2000) and the Umatilla Generating Project (from 2000-2002).

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I joined PSE at the end of March 2003 as the Manager of Project Development. In 2004, I was named Director of Resource Acquisition. In 2012, I was named Director of Financial Planning & Strategic Initiatives. While at PSE, I have been involved in the Frederickson 1, Hopkins Ridge, Wild Horse, Wild Horse expansion, Goldendale, Sumas, Mint Farm, and Lower Snake River Phase 1 acquisitions.
