Dear Mr. Petrie and Mr. Wendler:

As you are aware, on November 19, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 03, Classifying Budget Family Moving as a Household Goods Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease & Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance. A fine of \$5,000 was imposed for violations of RCW 81.80.075, \$4,500 of which was suspended on condition that the Company refrain from operating without a permit, and pay \$500 within 10 days of the effective date of the order. As of December 22, 2015, the Company has not complied with the conditions of Order 02, and the full penalty amount of \$5,000 became due and payable. The Commission sent Respondent a Corrected Final Notice dated June 24, 2016, indicating that the balance of \$5,000 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$5,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$5,000 balance.
