DECLARATION OF JASON HOXIT

I, Jason Hoxit, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington, declares as follows:

- I am over 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Washington, and competent to be a witness.
- I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as a Compliance Investigator in the Transportation Safety Division. As a Compliance Investigator, my responsibilities include conducting investigations into the operations of regulated and unregulated transportation companies. As part of those duties, I investigate charter party and excursion service carriers that may be operating without the required Commission-issued certificate.
- On November 14, 2018, the Commission entered Order 02, Stipulated Initial Order Classifying Respondent as Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing and Suspending Penalties on Condition of Future Compliance (Order 02). Order 02 assessed a penalty of \$10,000 against Duane Coggins, d/b/a Kokopelli's Run, (Kokopelli's Run or Company) for two violations of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.70.260(1) for operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington after the cancellation of its certificate.
- In Order 02, the Commission suspended a \$7,500 portion of the penalty for a period of two years on the conditions that: (1) Kokopelli's Run refrains permanently from further operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate from the Commission, and (2) Kokopelli's Run pays the remaining \$2,500 penalty in accordance with the payment schedule in Appendix A.
- On December 6, 2018, the Commission received the transcript from the November 14 special proceeding.² In the transcript, Duane Coggins acknowledges that: (1) the Company reviewed and understood Order 02 in its entirety, (2) the Company was penalized \$10,000 for advertising and offering to conduct operations after the cancellation of its certificate, (3) if the Commission found Kokopelli's Run advertising or offering to provide charter party or excursion carrier services during the two year suspension period, the Company would have

to pay the entire \$10,000 penalty, and (4) if the Commission found the Company operating in violation of the cease and desist order, Commission staff (Staff) may file a complaint with superior court and seek additional penalties.

- On April 19, 2019, Kokopelli's Run filed with the Commission an application to reinstate its charter and excursion authority.³ In the application, Kokopelli's Run provides a phone number of (509) 679-4743; lists a physical address of 800 E Wapato Way, Manson, WA 98831; lists a mailing address of PO Box 434, Manson, WA 98831, and identifies a 1999 Ford F550 bus with license plate ABA2391 as the only motor vehicle the Company operates.⁴
- On July 16, 2019, the Company's authority to provide charter party and excursion carrier service was reinstated by the Commission in Docket TE-190301.⁵ On August 13, 2019, Kokopelli's Run paid the \$2,500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended in full.
- On April 10, 2020, Kokopelli's Run filed with the Commission its request to cancel certificate CH-62592, citing the economic downturn caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.⁶ On April 10, the Commission issued a voluntary cancellation letter in Docket TE-200344 notifying Kokopelli's Run that its authority to provide charter party and excursion service is canceled and that the Company "must cease all operations associated with this certificate."⁷
- On September 22, 2020, I initiated a follow-up investigation of Kokopelli's Run to check for compliance with Order 02 in Docket TE-180805. On September 22, I searched Washington Department of Revenue's (DOR) Business Licensing Service, which produced records showing Kokopelli's Run as an active sole proprietor under UBI: 602-662-929; lists the governing person as Duane Coggins; lists a location address of 800 E Wapato Way, Manson, WA 98831; lists a mailing address of PO Box 434, Manson, WA 98831, and lists the Company's industry classification under charter bus.⁸
- On September 24, 2020, I searched Commission records, which produced records showing that Kokopelli's Run is not a certificated charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington.⁹

- On September 24, I visited the Company's website, <u>www.kokopellisrun.com</u>, which is no longer active. ¹⁰
- On September 24, I visited Kokopelli's Run's Facebook page. Under the about tab, the Company's Facebook page states, "Kokopelli's run [sic] is a shuttle service with two 27 passenger Busses [sic] and two 15 passenger Vans [sic] and we now feature a 31 passenger party bus." The Company's profile picture displays the phone numbers of (509) 679-4743 and (509) 322-7326.
- On September 24, I observed six separate posts on Kokopelli's Run's Facebook page where the Company advertises to provide charter party or excursion service after the cancellation of its certificate utilizing a 7-passenger Lincoln Navigator not including the driver, a 15-passenger Chevrolet van, a 21-passenger Chevrolet bus, and a 31-passenger Krystal Koach bus. ¹² In relation to charter and excursion carriers, a motor vehicle "means every self-propelled vehicle with seating capacity for seven or more persons, excluding the driver." ¹³
- The six separate posts on Kokopelli's Run's Facebook page range from June 18 to August 1, 2020, and the Company provides pictures of a 7-passenger Lincoln Navigator with license plate AOS0791; pictures of its 15-passenger Chevrolet van with license plate AER4912; pictures of its 21-passenger Chevrolet bus with license plate C32780J, and pictures of its 31-passenger Krystal Koach bus with California license plate 8CIH331.¹⁴
- On September 24, I sent a direct message under an assumed name to Kokopelli's Run through its Facebook page. In the message, I requested to book a beer and wine tour for 12 passengers in the Lake Chelan area between October 16 and October 26, 2020. Kokopelli's Run responded that it is available and requested to continue the conversation by phone. When I asked the Company whether to call (509) 679-4743 or (509) 322-7326, Kokopelli's Run directed me to call (509) 322-7326. ¹⁵
- On September 24, I called (509) 322-7326 and spoke with "Brian" of Kokopelli's Run. The Company offered our group of 12 the option of choosing a 31-passenger party bus or a 27-passenger bus for a beer and wine tour on October 22, 2020. When we settled on reserving the 27-passenger bus, Kokopelli's Run quoted a flat rate of \$900 for eight hours and stated the Company accepts payment via cash, single check, or the cash app Zelle. ¹⁶ Kokopelli's

Run also stated during the conversation that it would send me a text message with a list of local wineries, days and hours the wineries are open, and which locations require reservations in advance.

- On September 25, 2020, I received a text message from (509) 322-7326 that contains the names of local wineries, their respective business hours, reservation information, and website addresses for each winery.¹⁷
- On October 6, 2020, I searched Washington Department of Licensing's (DOL) DRIVES application for driver information on Orbie Duane Coggins. The records show that the 21-passenger Chevrolet bus with license plate C32780J, the 27-passenger Ford bus with license plate ABA2391, and the 31-passenger Krystal Koach bus with license plate BQS5239 are all motor vehicles associated with Orbie Duane Coggins.¹⁸
- On October 6, I searched DOL's DRIVES application for vehicle information. The records show that the 15-passenger Chevrolet van with license plate AER4912 is registered to Orbie Coggins; the 21-passenger Chevrolet bus with license plate C32780J is registered to Orbie Duane Coggins; the 27-passenger Ford bus with license plate ABA2391 is registered to Duane Coggins, and the 31-passenger Krystal Koach bus with license plate BQS5239 is registered to Orbie Duane Coggins.¹⁹
- On October 7, 2020, I searched DOL's DRIVES application for vehicle information on the Lincoln Navigator with license plate AOS0791, which produced records showing that the vehicle is registered to Brian Ellis.²⁰
- In response to the Company's failure to comply with the conditions of Order 02 in Docket TE-180805, specifically, the condition to refrain permanently from further operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate from the Commission, Staff recommends that the Commission impose the suspended penalty of \$7,500 against Kokopelli's Run.

DUANE COGGINS D/B/A KOKOPELLI'S RUN STIPULATED INITIAL ORDER CLASSIFYING RESPONDENT AS CHARTER PARTY OR EXCURSION SERVICE CARRIER; ORDERING RESPONDENT TO CEASE AND DESIST; IMPOSING AND SUSPENDING PENALTIES ON CONDITION OF FUTURE COMPLIANCE

BACKGROUND

Synopsis. This is an Administrative Law Judge's Initial Order that is not effective unless approved or allowed to become effective as described in the notice at the end of this Order. This Initial Order is based upon a stipulation presented by the parties. If this Initial Order becomes final, Duane Coggins, d/b/a Kokopelli's Run (Kokopelli's Run or Company) will be assessed a financial penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for two violations of RCW 81.70.260(1). A \$7,500 portion of the penalty will be suspended for a period of two years from the date of this order, then waived, subject to the condition that Kokopelli's Run refrains from further operation as charter party or excursion service carrier without first obtaining the required certificate from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission). In addition, if this Initial Order becomes final, Kokopelli's Run will be classified as a charter party or excursion service carrier and required to permanently cease and desist from operating as a charter party or excursion service carrier without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.

- Nature of Proceeding. The Commission initiated this special proceeding to determine if Kokopelli's Run has engaged, and is engaging, in unlawful operations following the cancellation of its charter party or excursion carrier certificate.
- Procedural History. On October 3, 2018, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Mandatory Appearance at Hearing, pursuant to RCW 81.04.510, initiating this docket on its own motion. The Complaint alleges that Kokopelli's Run violated RCW 81.70.260 by:

- (1) offering on at least one occasion to provide charter party or excursion service in the state of Washington;
- (2) advertising charter party or excursion services within the state of Washington on at least one occasion;

after the cancellation of their certificate required for such operations. On the same date, the Commission issued a *Subpoena and Subpoena Duces Tecum For Production of Documents* (Subpoenas) to the Company commanding Duane Coggins, owner of Kokopelli's Run, to appear before the Commission at a special proceeding scheduled to convene at 9:00 a.m. on November 14, 2018, in the Commission's offices at 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington, and to bring the documents specified in the *Subpoenas*.

- 3 **Hearing.** On November 14, 2018, the hearing convened as scheduled in Olympia, Washington, before Administrative Law Judge Laura Chartoff.
- 4 **Appearances.** Michael Turcott, Compliance Investigator, Olympia, Washington, represents the Commission's regulatory staff (Commission Staff). Duane Coggins, Manson, WA, represents the Company, *pro se*.

DISCUSSION

5 Applicable Law. RCW 81.70.020(1) defines "charter party carrier" as:

every person engaged in the transportation over any public highways in this state of a group of persons, who, pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, acquire the use of a motor vehicle to travel together as a group to a specified destination or for a particular itinerary, either agreed upon in advance or modified by the chartered group after leaving the place of origin.

6 RCW 81.70.020(5) defines "excursion service carrier" as:

every person engaged in the transportation of persons for compensation over any public highway in this state from points of origin within the incorporated limits of any city or town or area, to any other location within the state of Washington and returning to that origin.

7 RCW 81.70.260(1) defines "conduct any operations" as:

Advertising or soliciting, offering, or entering into an agreement to provide such service.

- RCW 81.70.260(1) prohibits charter party or excursion service carriers from conducting any operations after the cancellation or revocation of a certificate from the Commission. Upon proof of unauthorized operations, RCW 81.04.510 authorizes the Commission to order the unpermitted company to cease and desist its activities. Additionally, RCW 81.04.110 authorizes the Commission to file a complaint on its own motion setting forth any act or omission by a company that violates any law, order, or rule of the Commission.
- 9 RCW 81.70.260(2) subjects persons who conducts operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier of passengers in violation of RCW 81.70.260(1) a penalty of up to \$5,000 for each violation.
- Stipulation Presented by Parties. At hearing, Duane Coggins agreed that he has conducted operations in the state of Washington after the cancellation or revocation of the required certificate. The Company offered to provide charter party or excursion service carrier service on at least one occasion in the state of Washington and also advertised to operate as a charter party or excursion service carrier service in the state of Washington on at least one occasion.
- On October 5, 2016, the Commission notified Kokopelli's Run that it was cancelling its certificate (CH-062592) due to insufficient proof of insurance. The notice informed Kokopelli's Run that it must immediately cease all operations associated with the certificate.

- Duane Coggins has agreed to permanently shut down and cease operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier, as defined by RCW 81.70.020, without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.
- Under RCW 81.70.260(2), Commission Staff is authorized to seek a penalty of up to \$10,000 against the Company. Based upon the above-noted stipulation, Staff now seeks to have \$7,500 of the penalty suspended for two years, then waived, on the condition that the Company honors its pledge of future compliance by permanently staying out of the industry without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.
- The parties agree that the Company's expressed willingness to cease its unlawful operations is a positive factor, mitigating in favor of a lowered penalty amount to be paid now. The parties also agree that the Company's compliance history is a negative factor, making a penalty appropriate as a tool to ensure Kokopelli's Run does not re-enter the charter party or excursion service carrier business without first obtaining the required certificate.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 15 (1) The Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with authority to regulate persons conducting operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier for compensation over public roads in Washington.
- 16 (2) The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding and over Kokopelli's Run.
- On at least one occasion, Kokopelli's Run offered to conduct operations after the cancellation or revocation of a certificate from the Commission, in violation of RCW 81.70.260(1).
- On at least one occasion, Kokopelli's Run advertised to conduct operations after the cancellation or revocation of a certificate from the Commission, in violation of RCW 81.70.260(1).

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 19 (1) Kokopelli's Run is classified as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington.
- 20 (2) Kokopelli's Run is ordered to immediately cease and desist operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier within the state of Washington without first obtaining a certificate from the Commission.
- 21 (3) Kokopelli's Run is assessed a penalty of \$10,000. \$7,500 of the penalty is suspended for a period of two years from the date of this Order, and waived thereafter, provided Kokopelli's Run refrains permanently from further operations as a charter party or excursion service carrier in the state of Washington without first obtaining the required certificate from the Commission. The remainder of the penalty, \$2,500, is due and payable subject to the payment schedule in Appendix A.
- 22 (4) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties to this proceeding to effectuate the terms of this Order.

NOTICE TO THE PARTIES

This is an initial order. The action proposed in this initial order is not yet effective. If you disagree with this initial order and want the Commission to consider your comments, you must take specific action within the time limits outlined below. If you agree with this initial order, and you would like the Order to become final before the time limits expire, you may send a letter to the Commission, waiving your right to petition for administrative review.

WAC 480-07-825(2) provides that any party to this proceeding has twenty (20) days after the entry of this initial order to file a *Petition for Administrative Review*. Section (3) of the rule identifies what you must include in any petition as well as other requirements for a petition. WAC 480-07-825(4) states that any party may file an *Answer* to a Petition for review within (10) days after service of the petition.

WAC 480-07-830 provides that before the Commission enters a final order any party may file a petition to reopen a contested proceeding to permit receipt of evidence essential to a decision, but unavailable and not reasonably discoverable at the time of hearing, or for other good and sufficient cause. The Commission will not accept answers to a petition to reopen unless the Commission requests answers by written notice.

RCW 80.01.060(3), as amended in the 2006 legislative session, provides that an initial order will become final without further Commission action if no party seeks administrative review of the initial order and if the Commission fails to exercise administrative review on its own motion.

Any Petition or Response must be electronically filed through the Commission's web portal as required by WAC 480-07-140(5). Any Petition or Response filed must also be electronically served on each party of record as required by WAC 480-07-140(1)(b).

Brian stated that I referenced the Lake Chelan visitors guide in Facebook Messenger as to how I learned about Kokopelli's Run and asked for more details. I stated that I got ahold of the 2018/2019 Lake Chelan visitors guide and under the section for beer and wine tours it shows Kokopelli's Run along with about five other companies. I stated that I then searched and found the company through Facebook and here we are. Brian then asked me how I found both phone numbers for Kokopelli's Run and I stated that both (509) 322-7326 and (509) 679-4743 are listed on the company's Facebook page.

Brian asked about the size of the group and I stated there would be 12 of us, all from the same extended family. Brian stated that my Facebook message indicated we would be in the Lake Chelan area from October 16 through 26, 2020, and asked if I had a specific date in mind for the beer and wine tour. We then discussed the limited seating capacities of breweries and wineries, the common days and hours most facilities are open, how our group of 12 will likely need to be divided into smaller groups once we arrive at the wineries and breweries, and discussed how the county is still in a modified phase one reopening plan.

Brian also stated that some wineries require reservations and that he and his wife would put together a list of wineries, days and hours those locations are open, and which locations require reservations in advance. Brian stated that he would text me that list and confirmed my phone number of (360) 867-8305 as the number to text.

Brian initially stated that the company has openings for our group on October 17, 23, and 24, but then said the company's schedule is pretty open during the time we will be in the area. We eventually settled on Thursday, October 22, 2020, for an eight-hour beer and wine tour that would start around 11:00 AM and end before 8:00 PM since most locations are not open very late.

Brian then gave me the option of choosing a 31-passenger party bus with lights and a stripper pole or a 27-passenger "coach bus." I stated that it would potentially be uncomfortable for my family to book the 31-passenger bus, so we agreed on booking the 27-passenger bus for October 22.


