NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

AND

**NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT
DOCUMENTS OR STATUS REPORT**

(By August 2, 2019)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 12, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Mandatory Appearance at Hearing (Order 01) in Docket TV-190217. Order 01 required Move for Less LLC (Move for Less or Company) to appear before the Commission at a group classification proceeding set for May 14, 2019, at 9 a.m. On May 14, 2019, Yuriy Deyneka appeared at the special proceeding and requested a hearing to contest the allegations set forth in Order 01.

On May 16, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice of Classification Hearing; Setting Time for Oral Statements, set for July 22, 2019, at 1:30 p.m.

On July 17, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) notified the Commission that the parties have reached a settlement in principle, but request additional time to memorialize their agreement. Staff requests, on behalf of the parties, that the remaining procedural schedule in this matter be suspended and that the parties be permitted to file a settlement agreement or a report on the status of their settlement negotiations no later than August 2, 2019.

The Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule and therefore grants the parties' request. The parties must file a settlement agreement or a status report by August 2, 2019.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in this matter is suspended. The parties must file either a settlement agreement and supporting documentation or a status report of their negotiations no later than August 2, 2019.
