As you are aware, on August 25, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 02 Initial Order Granting Default; Classifying Respondent as a Household Goods Carrier; Ordering Respondent to Cease and Desist; Imposing Penalties in Docket TV-200029, and assessed a penalty in the amount of \$62,000. To date, no payments have been made.

The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated October 7, 2020, indicating that the balance of \$62,000 was due.

**This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event,** you likely would incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$62,000 balance.
