
The Commission is in receipt of your REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND RE-LOCATION OF HEARING, dated June 12, 1990, in the above cited matter. For the reasons herein discussed, the Commission denies the Respondent's Request.

The Commission notes at the outset that the allegations of the Complaint raise concerns that should be addressed in an expedited manner. The opportunities for the timely alternative scheduling of this matter are severely limited by the Commission's calendar.

The Commission is sympathetic to the need to accommodate parties when legitimate conflicts prevent participation in scheduled proceedings. However, the Commission cannot find sufficient basis in the Respondent's Request for granting the applied for relief.

Adequate notice of the hearing set in this matter has been given and the issues raised in this Complaint should be resolved as soon as possible. Therefore, the Commission will proceed with this matter as scheduled.
