Dear Secretary Washburn:

Since June 1992, when the Settlement and Operating Agreement (Docket No. UG-920487) went into effect, PSE has submitted reports reflecting the progress of the cast iron retirement program based upon a 'plan' year ending in June.

PSE and the WUTC staff have discussed changing the reporting dates such that PSE's progress reports will coincide with the calendar year and PSE's fiscal year. This will eliminate the planning, scheduling and budgeting issues that result from having the settlement year in the middle of the fiscal and calendar year.

PSE and the WUTC staff have reviewed Docket UG-920487 and agree that this change is in full compliance with the order.

Dear Mr. Kilpatrick:

Pursuant to Docket No. UG-920487, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) is required to submit semi-annual status reports reflecting the progress of the cast iron retirement program. In accordance with a PSE letter dated October 8, 2002 to the WUTC, PSE is revising the reporting dates to coincide with the calendar year and PSE's fiscal year. This letter provides the status report for cast iron retirement footage for 6 months ending June 30, 2002 and the cumulative retirement footage since the inception of the program.

Cast Iron Retirement for 6 months ending June, 30, 2002

In the first half of 2002, PSE completed the retirement of 3,600 feet of cast iron in the Seattle business area. Outside of the Seattle business area PSE retired 35,300 feet. PSE is on target to retire the final 500 feet within the Seattle Business Area this calendar year. PSE is also on target to complete the retirement of the remaining planned footage for 2002.
