**NOTICE OF WORKSHOP**

Re: Rulemaking to Make Corrections and Changes in Rules in WAC 480-07,  
Relating to Procedural Rules, Docket A-130355

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On March 30, 2017, the Commission issued a notice of opportunity to comment on proposed revisions to Part III B of the Commission's procedural rules, WAC 480-07. The Commission received written comments on May 15, 2017, and conducted a workshop on June 12, 2017. The Commission revised these draft proposed rules in response to the comments it received, and stakeholders provided additional written comments on December 1, 2017. The Commission has further revised the draft proposal in response to those comments.

Prior to formally proposing to adopt the revised rules, the Commission believes it would benefit from additional discussion with stakeholders on at least two issues:

1. How the Commission can best obtain the information it needs to render determinations in energy rate cases, including but not limited to whether the Commission should require parties in those cases to file work papers supporting the testimony and exhibits they intend to include in the evidentiary record; and
2. How the Commission can ensure that it and the parties have adequate access to any cost models a party presents in an energy rate case.

Accordingly, the Commission will conduct an additional workshop to address these issues on **Monday, February 5, 2018, beginning at 9:30 a.m. in Room 206, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**
