Additionally, this cover letter is provided to recognize that on December 10, 2019, PSE announced the proposed sale of its share of Colstrip Unit 4. If completed, the sale of Unit 4 would affect PSE's response to questions i and ii. The extent to which the answers to questions i and ii would differ if the sale were approved is not known at this time. PSE will be filing an application to dispose of Colstrip 4 with the Commission in the near future. Much of what is needed to answer the two questions will be addressed in the application. Therefore, PSE does not plan to update the second annual report as PSE will be able to more appropriately address the impacts of the sale of Colstrip Unit 4 if it is approved in the third annual report to be filed in November 2020.
