On June 19, 2000, the Commission entered the Ninth Supplemental Order in Docket UT-991358 authorizing Qwest Communications International, Inc. (Qwest), previously known as U S WEST, Inc.¹, to file certain tariff revisions complying with the terms of that Order. On July 28, 2000, Qwest filed with the Commission certain tariff revisions purporting to comply with the Commission's Order. On August 29, 2000, the company amended the original filing, incorporating suggestions of Commission Staff and Public Counsel, and refiled the tariff revisions, adding language to clarify the Consumer Bill of Rights. Additionally, the company agrees to mail a complete copy of the Customer Bill of Rights to customers prior to December 31, 2000. The company will also consider additional methods of notification.

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed by Qwest on August 29, 2000, with a stated effective date of August 31, 2000, comply with the Commission's Ninth Supplemental Order in Docket UT-991358 and that the tariff revisions should be approved and become effective as filed.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the tariff revisions filed August 29, 2000, by Qwest in accordance with the Ninth Supplemental Order in this proceeding, and by this reference made a part of this Order as though fully set forth herein, shall become effective as filed.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this and prior Orders entered in this proceeding.
