Pursuant to paragraph 118 of the Multiparty Settlement Stipulation and Agreement in the above-referenced dockets, Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) hereby confirms that on December 6, 2019 it placed \$5,000,000 of monetized Production Tax Credits into an escrow account to fund the Colstrip community transition plan.
