ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric

customers in the Pacific Northwest. A list of ICNU members is included as

Attachment A. Many members of ICNU purchase power from PacifiCorp, as indicated

on Attachment A, and represent some of PacifiCorp's largest customers.

4 ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in PacifiCorp's

application in this proceeding. PacifiCorp has requested to defer costs associated with

hydro generation in order to track and preserve these costs for later incorporation in rates.

Any Commission decision regarding the treatment of these costs could have an impact on

the rates that PacifiCorp provides to ICNU's members.

PacifiCorp's last rate case, which was docketed as UE-032065, ended in

November of 2004. PacifiCorp was authorized to file the rate case because the

Commission amended the five-year Rate Plan that would have prevented PacifiCorp from

increasing rates until January 1, 2006. The Rate Plan barred PacifiCorp from filing this

type of deferred accounting Petition. This petition should be rejected because the

Commission did not abrogate the entire Rate Plan.

In addition, PacifiCorp could and should have included any power costs,

including hydro generation costs, in its last rate case, instead of filing for a deferred

account a mere five months after the conclusion of that case. Deferred accounting was

meant to allow recovery of expenses in unforeseeable and extreme cases. There were no

unforeseeable and extreme changes in hydro conditions in the past several months.

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According to its application in this proceeding, PacifiCorp will file a general rate case in the near future. Issues such as this are best addressed through a rate case, and ICNU opposes PacifiCorp's request for a deferred account outside of the impending rate case. PacifiCorp continues to abuse and overuse deferred accounting, which should only occur in cases of extreme, unforeseeable events. It is foreseeable that there will be good and poor hydro years, and current power costs reflect the variation in the availability of hydro. Good and bad hydro years are accounted for in PacifiCorp's power cost models.

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ICNU represents the interests of a number of PacifiCorp's industrial electric customers. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

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As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.
