
PETITION FOR AUTHORIZATION OF
FREE OR REDUCED RATES FOR
CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION
SERVICE WITHIN KLICKITAT COUNTY

- 1 COMES NOW Rabanco, Ltd. d/b/a Tri-County Disposal, G-12, (“Tri-County Disposal”),
1600 127th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington, 98005, by and through their counsel,
Williams Kastner & Gibbs PLLC and David W. Wiley, 601 Union Street, Suite 4100, Seattle,
Washington, 98101, and hereby petitions the Washington Utilities and Transportation
Commission (“the Commission”), pursuant to RCW 81.28.080(5) and WAC 480-70-
336(2)(a), seeking Commission approval, pursuant to WAC 480-70-336(2)(a) and (c), to
provide curbside recycling services at no charge for residents of Klickitat County.
- 2 As required by WAC 480-70-336, the Company is also noting in accompanying tariff pages
filed herewith as Exhibits 1, the applicability of no charge for curbside residential recycling.
- 3 Finally, pursuant to WAC 480-70-336(4), the Company’s owners acknowledge they will be
responsible for the uncollected revenue by providing recycling service at free rates on the
affected tariff pages. In short, the solid waste ratepayer customer will not subsidize the no
charge revenue stream herein.
- 4 WHEREFORE, Tri-County Disposal, respectfully asks that the attached tariff pages for free
and reduced residential curbside recycling collection service within Klickitat County be
approved by the Commission, and that it be authorized to publish the attached pages in its
tariff as part of the Commission’s Decision and Order in this docket.

Curbside recycling (N) provisions shown on this page apply only in the following service area:

KLICKITAT COUNTY

Following is a description of the recycling program (type of containers, frequency, etc.). Program provided in accordance with Ordinance No. _____ of _____ (name of County or City).

Special rules related to recycling program:

The program shall include curbside collection of recyclable materials from single family households and multifamily residences. Curbside collection shall include newspaper, cardboard, aluminum, mixed paper, tin cans, and other materials identified in the County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan. Materials shall be collected on a regular shedule at least monthly. There shall be no cost to the County or its redients for curbside collection of recyclables.

Recyclables are to be bagged in a clear blue bag which can be obtained from Tri-County Disposal once the Residential customer has signed up for this service. Bags can be placed at the curb to be collected every other week (contact company for specific customer collection day). Recyclables do not have to be sorted. Glass is not to be recycled at the curb (do not place it in the bag). A detailed list of recyclable materials as per the County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan can be found in the "new customer" package provided by Tri-County Disposal upon sign up or at KlickitatCounty.org/SolidWaste.

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
