NOTICE OF ADHERENCE TO PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

RE: *In re Application of Dolly, Inc., for a Permit to Operate as a Motor Carrier of Household Goods and a Permit to Operate as a Motor Freight Common Carrier, Docket TV-180605*

On July 6, 2018, Dolly, Inc. (Dolly or Company) filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) for authority to operate in Washington as a household goods carrier and motor freight common carrier (Application).

On September 21, 2018, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Application for Permanent Authority and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this matter based on its review and investigation of the Application. On October 5, 2018, Dolly filed with the Commission a Request for Adjudicative Proceeding on the intended denial of the Company's Application. The Commission issued a Notice of Hearing (Notice) on October 15, 2018.

On October 11, 2018, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a Motion for Summary Determination (Motion). Staff contends that Dolly's lengthy history of noncompliance with Commission orders renders the Company unfit to hold operating authority as a matter of law.

On November 2, 2018, Dolly filed its Response Opposing Staff's Motion, claiming that the Company is entitled to a hearing on its regulatory fitness. Staff subsequently filed a motion for leave to reply to Dolly's response, and Dolly filed a response opposing that motion.

The Commission will take Staff's Motion under advisement and does not anticipate ruling on it prior to the hearing currently scheduled on December 19, 2018. The parties, therefore, must continue to adhere to the procedural schedule and requirements established in the Notice.
