Commission Staff and Rainier View Water Company, Inc., (collectively "the Parties") jointly move the Commission to accept the Settlement Agreement filed in the above-captioned case on March 1, 2005. The Settlement Agreement allows a conservation rate of \$5.00 per 100 cubic feet used in excess of 3,000 cubic feet to go into effect each year between May 1 and September 30. The proposed conservation rate raises the charge for water usage over 3,000 cubic feet from \$0.85 per 100 cubic feet to \$5.00 per cubic feet.
