During a scheduling conference in this docket held on Monday, February 6, 2006, participants in the conference agreed upon the following schedule for the purpose of determining non-impaired wire centers in Washington State:

Friday, February 10, 2006:

Commission enters protective order

Monday, February 13, 2006:

Commission staff will circulate an informal list of the information sought from Qwest and Verizon.

Tuesday, February 21, 2006:

Commission enters order to Qwest and Verizon requesting data concerning alleged non-impaired wire centers in Washington State.

- Tuesday, February 28, 2006:** Qwest and Verizon file requested data with the Commission and with any CLECs or their employees who have filed the appropriate exhibits to the protective order.
- Tuesday, March 7, 2006:** Exceptions to Qwest and Verizon data or requests for additional data must be filed with the Commission.
- Tuesday, March 14, 2006:** Qwest and Verizon file responses to exceptions or requests for additional data, or may file additional data with the Commission.
- Tuesday, March 21, 2006:** Interested persons must state agreement with Qwest and Verizon non-impairment designations or file state final exceptions or objections.
- Friday, March 31, 2006:
(target date)** Commission will endeavor to issue notice of non-impaired wire centers in Washington State, resolving any remaining disputes.
