7	Transportation Commission versus Olympic Moving &
8	Storage, Inc., d/b/a Olympic Movers. Today's date is
9	Monday, January 5th, 2015, it is now a little after
10	9:30 a.m., and we are here for a prehearing
11	conference. My name is Gregory J. Kopta, the
12	administrative law judge presiding.
13	We will begin by taking appearances. Let's
14	start with Commission Staff.
15	MR. BEATTIE: Your Honor, Julian
16	Beattie, Assistant Attorney General, appearing on
17	behalf of Commission Staff.
18	JUDGE KOPTA: And for the Company?
19	MR. REHBERGER: Joseph Rehberger for
20	Olympic Moving & Storage.
21	JUDGE KOPTA: Does anyone else wish to

23	Hearing none. When last we left our heroes,

- 18 file responsive testimony and exhibits by Friday,
- 19 April 3rd, 2015; Staff rebuttal testimony be due
- 20 approximately two weeks later, on April 17, 2015; that
- 21 a discovery deadline be imposed for Friday,
- 22 April 24th, 2015; that the deadline for filing of
- cross-examination exhibits be set for Monday, May 18,
- 24 2015; that the evidentiary hearing in this matter be
- 25 set for two weeks after that deadline, on Monday,

- June 1st, 2015; and that posthearing briefs be due
- 2 from each party on June 19, 2015.
- JUDGE KOPTA: And is the Company in
- 4 agreement with this proposed schedule?
- 5 MR. REHBERGER: Yes, the schedule is
- 6 fine for the Company. We did just receive it this
- 7 morning, so I haven't actually checked the hearing
- 8 date with my client. It's fine with my schedule.
- 9 JUDGE KOPTA: All right. I need to make
- 10 sure that that hearing date works for us as well.
- 11 What I ask is that you get back to me as soon as you
- 12 have had a check with your client, hopefully within
- 13 the next day or two, to confirm that that date works.
- MR. REHBERGER: I can do that.
- JUDGE KOPTA: I will check on my end
- 16 before issuing an order adopting the schedule.
- 17 All right. I think that's it. I would ask
- 18 that we keep to this schedule unless you actually have
- 19 a settlement agreement in hand. So if we are going to
- 20 suspend this once again, then let's actually have a
- 21 settlement agreement that is signed on the dotted line
- 22 so that we don't have to do this again.
- MR. BEATTIE: Understood.
- 24 MR. REHBERGER: Thank you, Your Honor.
- 25 JUDGE KOPTA: All right. Anything else
