RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc.*
Commission Staff's Notice of Compliance and Recommendation to Close Docket
Docket TV-190694

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On September 6, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$6,100 penalty in Docket TV-190694 against Iron Man Movers and Storage, Inc., (Iron Man Movers or Company) for violations of WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 CFR Part 391 – Qualifications of Drivers.

On September 23, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, which granted payment arrangements for Iron Man Movers to pay the \$6,100 penalty in 12 monthly installments. Order 01 further held that if Iron Man Movers “fails to pay any portion of the assessed penalty by the due date, the Commission may cancel the Company’s household goods permit by order in this docket.”¹

On April 3, 2020, the Commission issued a notice suspending the Company’s payment plan for a period of six months due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The notice stated that “All other terms and conditions of Order 01 remain in full force and effect.”

On September 4, 2020, Iron Man Movers paid the \$6,100 penalty in full. Commission staff finds that Iron Man Movers satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the Commission close the docket and allow Iron Man Movers to retain its household goods authority.
