<u>Funding for the project</u> was awarded in January by the UTC's Grade Crossing Protective Fund. BNSF, which owns the trains tracks, contributed another \$10,000 for in-kind labor to the projects. NDP estimated that the total cost of the improvements to be \$52,400.
