TO ALL PARTIES:

Since the last scheduled status conference in these proceedings, the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia has upheld a decision of the Federal Communications Commission concerning compensation for Internet service provider (ISP) bound traffic.¹ In addition, the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals dismissed an appeal by Level 3 Communications, LLC (Level 3), concerning an Arizona Corporations Commission decision addressing compensation for ISP-bound traffic.² Given the decisions in these two cases, it is appropriate to discuss whether and how to proceed in the present cases.
