On October 20, 2008, Judge Clark sent an email to all parties noting ministerial discrepancies in exhibit numbering in the above mentioned docket. Specifically, the exhibit numbering of William E. Avera and William G. Johnson were noted. Based on the email, we have made the following changes:

- 1. For William E. Avera's testimony and exhibits, the exhibits identified as "WEA Schedules" that incorrectly started with the numbering WEA-1 have been changed.
