VERIZON DATA REQUEST NO. 46: What is the smallest number of households that Dr. Jussaume believes could constitute a “community or partial community” provided that they possessed the two “indispensable” attributes of community described in his direct testimony?

The issue of the smallest or largest number of households that can constitute a community is not addressed in the sociological literature on communities. This is possibly because community sociologists generally view the viability of a community as a product of the social interaction of those who are involved in a community rather than the number of members.
