BACKGROUND

- On November 28, 2001, Harold LeMay Enterprises Inc., d/b/a Eastern Gays Harbor Disposal (Eastern) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff Number 18, designated as third revision page 1, first revision page 10, first revision page 12, first revision page 17, and third revision page 18. The stated effective date is January 5, 2002. The filing is to recover a disposal fee increase mandated by Grays Harbor County.
- WAC 480-70-266 requires forty days' notice prior to the effective date of the tariff. The tariff sheet bears an inserted effective date of January 5, 2002. This date recognizes statutory notice as required. Eastern requests, however, that statutory notice be waived as authorized in WAC 480-70-276, and that the revisions become effective January 1, 2002

FINDINGS

After careful examination of the proposed tariff revisions filed by Eastern on November 21, 2001, and giving consideration to all relevant matters and for good cause shown, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff revisions should become effective January 1, 2002.

ORDER

3 IT IS ORDERED that the Carrier is authorized to implement and collect the rates contained in Docket TG-011561.

THE COMMISSION GRANTS the requested waiver of statutory notice in connection with the tariff revisions filed by Eastern on November 21, 2001, and the tariff revisions shall become effective on January 1, 2002.
