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BACKGROUND

- 1 On November 28, 2001, Harold LeMay Enterprises Inc., d/b/a City Sanitary Co., Joe's Refuse Service and White Pass Garbage Service G-98 and Nancy LeMay d/b/a City Sanitary G-47 (LeMay) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff Number 9.1, designated as eighth revision page 1, sixth revision page 12, and fourth revision page 14. The stated effective date is January 12, 2002. The filing is to adjust the curbside recycle commodity credit.

- 2 WAC 480-70-266 requires forty days' notice prior to the effective date of the tariff. The tariff sheet bears an inserted effective date of January 12, 2002. This date recognizes statutory notice as required. LeMay requests, however, that statutory notice be waived as authorized in WAC 480-70-276, and that the revisions become effective January 1, 2002

FINDINGS

After careful examination of the proposed tariff revisions filed by LeMay on November 28, 2001, and giving consideration to all relevant matters and for good cause shown, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff revisions should become effective January 1, 2002.

ORDER

3 IT IS ORDERED that the Carrier is authorized to implement and collect, the rates
contained in Dockets TG-011579 and TG-011580.

4 THE COMMISSION GRANTS the requested waiver of statutory notice in
connection with the tariff revisions filed by LeMay on November 28, 2001, and the
tariff revisions shall become effective on January 1, 2002.
